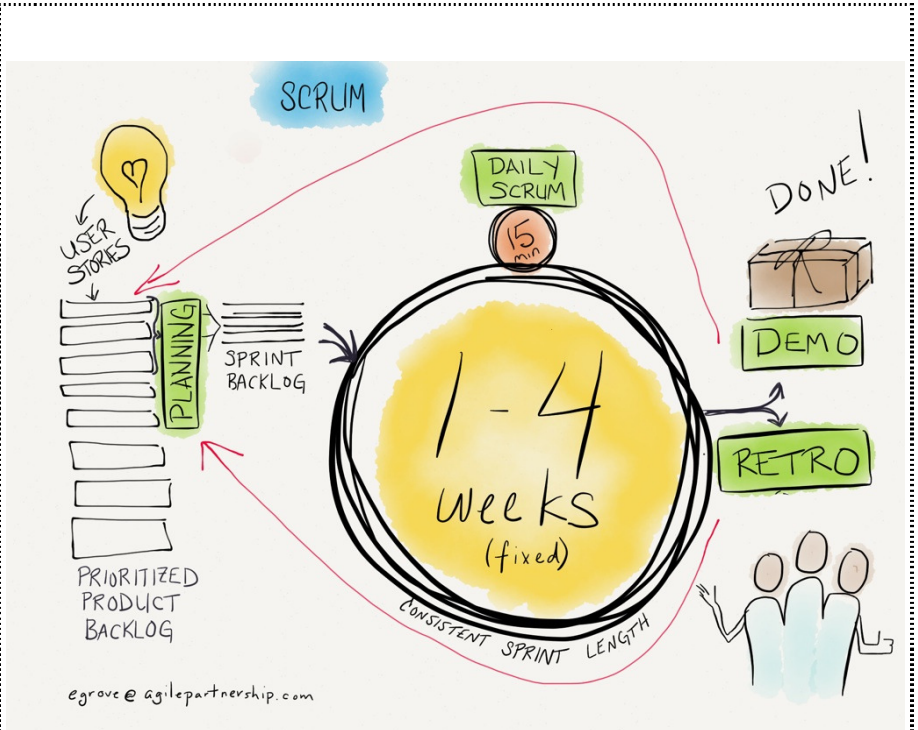


## Scrum Fundamentals

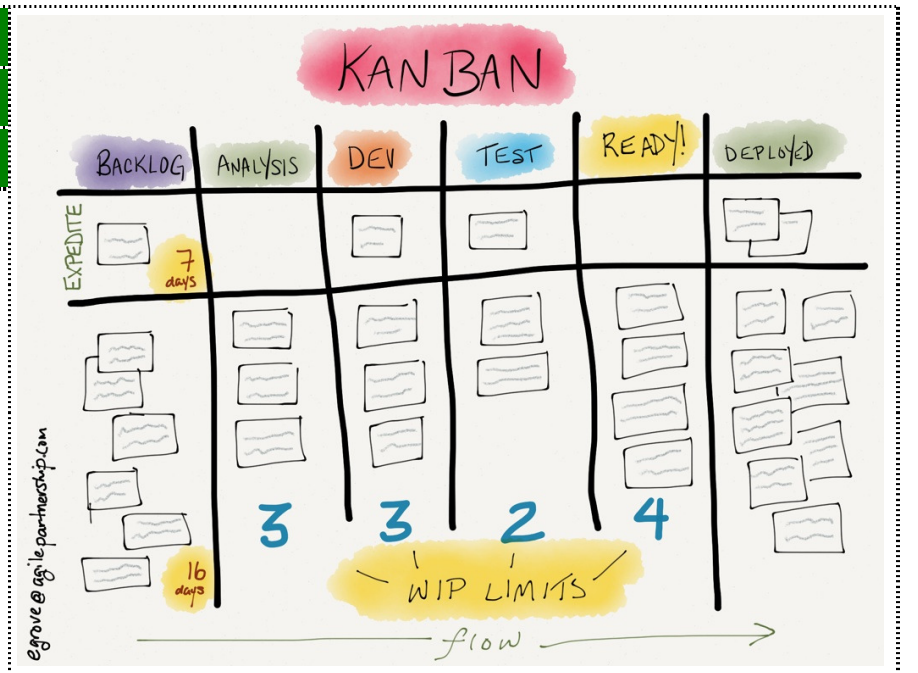
1 dedicated team	A Scrum team consists of dedicated members who have all the skills required to deliver completed work
2 products	Potentially shippable work A stronger team
3 roles	Product Owner Scrum Master Team member
4 meetings	Sprint Planning Daily Scrum Sprint Review Sprint Retrospective
5 artifacts	Product Backlog User Stories Sprint Goal Sprint Backlog Definition of Done



The Product Owner builds and prioritizes a backlog in consultation with the team. In sprint planning, the team commits to deliver items from the top of the backlog. Through the sprint, the team meets daily to coordinate their progress and identify what's blocking them. At the end of the sprint, the team's work is demonstrated at the sprint review and the team considers how it's working at the retrospective. Feedback from the review and retrospective goes into the planning of the next sprint.
